



OPEN DATA CODE OF CONDUCT

1. **Data Use Code of Conduct**

Devon Community Foundation encourages others to access, use and discuss our open data in working towards a strong community and voluntary sector in Devon. We ask that you observe the following Code of Conduct when doing so.

2. **Accessing our data**

When accessing our data, we request that you do not place unnecessary burden on our servers by making repeated data requests over a short period of time.

3. **Attribution**

When using our data, we request that our licence is observed. When producing any material that uses our data, please ensure an attribution to Devon Community Foundation is included.

4. **Derivation**

When making use of our data, always state any steps that were made to undertake calculations or analysis that are not present in the source.

5. **Violations**

When using Devon Community Foundation data, you must not:

- pretend to represent the Devon Community Foundation;
- present the data in a misleading or incorrect manner or misrepresent or change the data;
- use the name Devon Community Foundation for party political purposes;
- use the data in or to support a criminal or illicit activity;
- use the data to make comments that are racist, sexist or homophobic, or which promote or incite violence.
